DRUM JOINS ELRUM & FRUM IN ACTION OF LEGAL DEMONSTRATION AT THE U A W SOLIDARITY HOUSE IN PROTEST OF THE RACIST POLICY IN THE AUTO INDUSTRY.....

We the super-exploited Black workers of Eldon Ave. Gear & Axle Plant of Chrysler Corp, called for a strike on Monday, Jan 27, 1969 at Eldon Axle Plant in protest of the racist working conditions & arbitrary (based on Chrysler's management preference, notion, or whim) WRITE-UPS on Black workers personal records/getting fired on TRUMP-UP charges of insubordination (not submitting to white supremacy), tardiness, misuse of company property, & anything else that these racists thugs can think of.

As a result of this Black unity, management waited until Friday, Jan. 31, 1969, four (4) days after the strike to fire/to discharge fifty (50) Black workers with-out any U A W representation. This is an OUT & OUT violation & flagrant (outrageous) abuse of the U A W contract between the workers & Chrysler Corp. Besides this write-ups to days off were given to other Black workers that the management get the TOMS to squell on.

To deal with this notorious action, the Black workers of DRUM, FRUM, ELRUM HARUM, AMRUM, & UPRUM propose on Monday, Feb. 10, 1969 at 8:00 AM, that we will stage a legal demonstration at the U A W Solidarity House in protest of the racist policy in the auto-industry, in demanding that the company honor its contract, the reinstatement of the fifty (50) Black workers discharged at Eldon Axle & that the union acts accordingly in protecting the Black workers basic rights. We are asking support from all struggle conscious Black workers in the U A W paying union dues to join with these BROTHERS in this fight to make the world see how the U A W has never taken a firm stand against the racist practices of management thru-out the auto-industry. The arbitrary firing of fifty (50) Black workers at Eldon Axle is most significant of this. STOP & THINK WILL YOU BE NEXT? JOIN US IN
