THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES:

- (1) That at all times hereinafter mentioned and within the meaning of Section 3(i) and 3(j) of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (29 U.S.C. 402(i) and 402(j)), hereinafter referred to as the Act:
 - a. Local Union 961, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America, hereinafter referred to as the Union, was and is a labor organization representing employees engaged in an industry affecting commerce and had its principal office in Detroit, Michigan.
 - b. At all times hereinafter referred to, FRANCIS
 D. McKINNON was President of the Union and as such was
 a representative of employees engaged in an industry
 affecting interstate commerce and an officer of a Labor
 organization within the meaning of said Act.
- (2) That during the period between June 1, 1971 and June 30, 1972, in the Eastern District of Michigan, Southern Division, FRANCIS D. McKINNON, wilfully caused to be made false entries in the books and records of said Union required to be kept by the provisions of Title II of said Act (29)

U.S.C. 431, et seq.), in that he misrepresented information in lost time vouchers he submitted to the Union; in violation of said Act, 29 U.S.C. 439(c).
