WOMEN HAVE WORK NOW, Says Council

“I don't think that men, in the if, will be hard to find,” said the council member.

“For the total effect of this measure and the amount of the money represented here, and the City Council just might get some help.”

The hearing was arranged four days by members of the Democratic Party and those aided by Donald Comings, right-wing Democrat, Councilor, and the Labor Party representatives were opposed to the additional for “female” demands out of unemployment benefits.

Allen had as director of the city's employment program, explained the city use of CETA funds, a program criticized by some of the speakers.

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“We are required to spend all the money by specific periods of time, and we intend to do so,” Trecker said.

“What there is no possibility that there might be some surplus, but we just don't know when they get.”

Councilman Clyde Cleckley, who chaired the hearing, said that the Council would take some action to be provisionally related to the matter.

“The federal government has provided money across the country for 500,000 jobs, and just to Kalamazoo alone there are 100,000 job problems... an impossible situation,” said Cleckley.

“I'd like the Council to try and get the federal government to agree that our governments should become the employer of last resort... when a person cannot get a job anywhere else.”

A representative from the newly created Workers' Action Coalition for Jobs, Hunt, Wilson, told the council that factory employed workers were “in a greatly mood.”

The audience cheered when Wilson said, “We're in a great need of jobs and we need them now, not when our babies are on the street, our furniture is piled up and our families walk the streets without shelter or food.”

“Probably there isn't enough money in the federal government to provide people with jobs, but that's not the point. The point is they dipped in and got out, and for the first time in 10 years they're back in the hole of the unemployment line.”

Heldman said that many were unemployed.

“We're going to have a real problem,” he said.
