## An Outline of the meeting with CL

The struggle with JS on the way re the structure of the Congress:

From this discussion we obtained the principle that the primary struggle in this period of time is the struggle against factionalism. Given the general history in this country we can see that every communist party has faced and not solved the problem of factionalism (the concrete details of this are in the Dialectics of the Development of the Communist League). In particular, the history of the "new" left is one where "leaders" gather around themselves a coterie of people and establish an "organization". The second fact is that nine times out of ten the rank and file is more progressive, more honest than the leadership. This means that in terms of what must be accomplished at the Congress, we must have a full Congress where the leadership and the rank and file all can come and assess for themselves the content of what is being run. The problem of security is not crucial precisely because all those who are coming have been exposed in one way or another. This is not to say that security precautions must not be taken but rather to say that we cannot sacrifice the content of what we must accomplish in order to have security.

When we got there we then had a good raucous drinking party. The essence of that "discussion" was to prove that this will damned well be a workers' party although they will have high theoretical development. It is clear that we will have a resident and a working central committee; this means that we will eliminate the old pattern of the privileged leadership pimping off the rest of the organization. All central committee members will be expected to work at least four hours a week.

The meetin the next morning started at about 11:00 A.M. The first item on the agenda was the question of factionalism: The general discussion included: 1) the material basis for factionalism in USNA parties; 2) a specific discussion of groups that are now coming onto the local and national continuation committees and how they are functioning; 3) the possibilities of splits at the Congress and the centrality of protecting Marxism-Leninism and specifically the national question.

Remember that Marxism is not up for debate. The resolutions in M-L Unite are and must be the basis of the Party program. The continuation committees are not organizing committees--they continue the content of the Conference. Position papers are being drafted on all the material resolutions and on the program.

The first item on the agenda of the Congress will be the dissolution of all the organizations. Then we will proceed through the Congress. The last item on the agenda will be the imposition of absolute centralism.

The rest of the items that were covered on the agenda can be discussed with the specifics--e.g. going through the program and explaining the nature of the struggle. Two further discussions that must be outlined are those on the united front against fascism and the discussion of the CPUSA.
