Please accept my resignation from the National Interim Committee for all of the political reasons spelled out in the paper The Political Line of the Motor City Labor League Marxist Leninist which is being sent under separate cover.

Please also excuse the delay in sending this since our position has been clear for some time. I had hoped to complete and will be sending shortly a considerably longer letter supplementing the paper regarding my own personal development in coming to unite with the position of the paper.

We do hope that arrangements can be made for Arthur to come to Detroit at an early opportunity to discuss our position with members of the Central Committee. We will be in touch shortly to work out details.

I trust that the necessary arrangements to remove my name from the stationary and other documents will be made immediately. As the longer letter will make clear, I retain great respect and affection for many of the individuals who have been involved in the discussions and debates which have emanated from Arthur's paper. We will no doubt continue to meet in the long and difficult struggle ahead.
