Historical presentation of the Q theoretically:

1) Oct. Rev. 1917, Stimulated nat'l born leadership. Must be prot. rev.

2) All national Qs became nat'l + colonial Q. New Democracy - in colonial, semi-colonial semi-feudal states - wd not at first stage be a prot. rev. It would

free the dev't of capitalism. Overthrow feudalism, Productive forces freed up, Don't have dictatorship of prot.

Q of land distribution - peasantry moves to set rev. base for capitalism. leading element is prot. but leading force is peasantry.

Dictatorship of prot. w/ "united front"

→ See Ethiopian Students - say it is semi-feudal

Internal conditions are basis for change

- Capitalism grows out of feudalism, Socialism out of capitalism. No socialism out of feudalism + no capitalism out of socialism.

But in China there was still feudalist relationships throughout China - but material base (socialism) had created the ability to move to socialist relationships.
