We wish to inform the Union brothers and sisters in the D.A.P. of the formation of the DAP Unemployment Committee. Its purpose will be to unite the unemployed and employed workers in the struggle against unemployment. OUR PROGRAM TO HELP THOSE UNEMPLOYED AND TO FIGHT UNEMPLOYMENT IS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) For help and information to obtain all due benefits and to fight the red tape, penalties and harassment which daily rob many workers of their compensation, also the threat of repossessions and evictions.

- (2) WE DEMAND THE FORMATION OF UNEMPLOYMENT COMMITTEES THROUGHOUT THE UAW. WE WILL TRY TO MOBILIZE THE UNION AROUND THE FOLLOWING PROGRAM TO INCREASE EMPLOYMENT:
 - (a) Full seniority rights for all laid-off workers
 - (b) Shorter work week, with no reduction in pay, 30 hours work, 40-hours pay.
 - (c) No forced overtime while workers are laid off.
 - (d) Full SUB pay for everyone for the duration of the layoff, to be paid by the company.
 - (e) Back pay for hiring-in rates under Art.9, Section 2 (D) MASTER CONTRACT.
