IT HAS ONLY COME THROUGH THE TRANSITION FROM THE LEAGUE STYLE OF WORK TO THE PARTY, HAS THE NEED BEEN REALIZED FOR SPECIFIC, DETAILED ANALYSIS OF HOW MUCH OF A DENT OUR WORK HAS HAD ON THE WORKING CLASS STRUGGLE IN THE FACE OF THE RISING DEVELOPMENT OF FASCISM, ESTABLISHING THE UNITED FRONT, BUILDING A MULTI-NATIONAL COMMUNIST PARTY, ESTABLISHING ROUTE SYSTEM, ETC.
